

RESOLUTION OF SPONSORSHIP

For a Transportation Alternative Program Application and Maintenance Commitment

Resolution No. 2016-47

A resolution declaring the eligibility and intent of the Village of Angel Fire to submit an application to the New Mexico Department of Transportation for Federal Fiscal Year 2018/2019 for Transportation Alternative Program (TAP) funds.

Whereas, the Village of Angel Fire, New Mexico, has the legal authority to apply for, receive and administer federal funds; and,

Whereas, the Village of Angel Fire, is submitting an application for Federal Fiscal Year 2018/2019 (FFY18/19) New Mexico Transportation Alternative Program (TAP) funds in the amount of \$650.000, as set forth by the Federal legislation, Fixing America's Surface Transportation (FAST) Act, and as outlined in the FFY 18/19 New Mexico TAP/RTP Guide; and,

Whereas, the Sidewalk Improvements, Crosswalks and Addition of New Sidewalks named in the Transportation Alternative Program (TAP) application are eligible project(s) under New Mexico Transportation Alternative Program (TAP) and the FAST Act; and,

Whereas, the Village of Angel Fire, acknowledges availability of the required local match of 14.56% and the availability of funds to pay all costs up front, as the Transportation Alternative Program (TAP) is a cost reimbursement program; and,

Whereas, the Village of Angel Fire agrees to pay any costs that exceed the project amount if the application is selected for funding; and,

Whereas, the Village of Angel Fire agrees to maintain all project(s) constructed with Transportation Alternative Program (TAP) funding for the useable life of the project(s);

Now, therefore be it resolved by the governing body of the Village of Angel Fire, that:

- 1. The Village of Angel Fire, authorizes Projects and Grants to submit an application for FFY18/19 New Mexico TAP funds in the amount of \$650.000, from the New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) on behalf of the Village of Angel Fire.**
- 2. That the Village of Angel Fire, assures the NMDOT that if Transportation Alternative Program funds are awarded, sufficient funding for the local match and for upfront project costs are available, since TAP is a reimbursement program, and that any costs exceeding the award amount will be paid for by the Village of Angel Fire.**


3. That the Village of Angel Fire assures the NMDOT that if awarded Transportation Alternative Program (TAP) funds, sufficient funding for the operation and maintenance of the Transportation Alternative Program (TAP) project will be available for the life of the project.

4. That the Projects and Grants Department for the Village of Angel Fire is authorized to enter into a Cooperative Project Agreement with the NMDOT for Transportation Alternative Program funding program (TAP) projects using these funds as set forth by the FAST Act on behalf of the citizens of the Village of Angel Fire. The Projects and Grants Department is also authorized to submit additional information as may be required and act as the official representative of the Village of Angel Fire in this and subsequent related activities.

5. That the Village of Angel Fire assures the NMDOT that the Village of Angel Fire is willing and able to administer all activities associated with the proposed project.
