Angel Fire Proud Meeting Minutes
March 25, 2014 at 2:00pm at Village Hall

- I. Call to Order
The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Lysa Hopson.
- II. Pledge of Allegiance
Chairperson Lysa Hopson called for the Pledge of Allegiance.
- III. Roll Call
Present at the meeting were Chuck Howe, Lisa Mitchell, Linda Hughes, Lysa Hopson, Johnese Turri, Tracy Orr and Dennis Edwards for Carolyn Edwards. A quorum was established.
- IV. Approval of March 25, 2014 Agenda
A motion was made by Lisa Mitchell to approve the agenda as written. The motion was seconded by Linda Hughes and passed unanimously.
- V. Approval of February 25, 2014 Meeting Minutes
Lisa Mitchell made a motion to approve the meeting minutes from the February 25, 2014 meeting. Linda Hughes seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.
- VI. Old Business
 - A. Christmas Decorations-Tracy Orr reported that the snowflakes and skier will be removed on or before April 4, 2014.
 - B. Flowers and Banners
 1. Spring and Summer Projects-The Committee discussed having a contest for homeowners and business owners called "Pot of the Month", which is one or more flower pots filled with flowers. The Committee could talk to the nursery's about discounts on flowers and the lumber yards for discounts on planters and potting soil. We would have a traveling sign that goes from place to place depending who wins that month. This is a great way to encourage business owners to "spruce up" the front of their businesses. Lysa Hopson said she will continue searching for decorations for the light poles on Highway 434. The Committee discussed white rope lights on the poles to decorate them. This program can be presented at the May 8th Business After Hours and the May 10th Cleanup Day as well as the AAFPO meeting and Garden Week. The contest can also be announced through the Village Voice on the back of the water bills. Tracy Orr also reported that she has money from New Mexico Clean and Beautiful for the flower pots in front of the Village, the median on N. Angel Fire Road, the Community Center and the Fire Station for planting and beautification.

- 1 a. Clean Up Day-May 10th-The details for Clean Up Day were discussed.
2 Tracy Orr reported that she needs to pick up the clean up supplies in Santa
3 Fe. She also stated that the Wagon Mound Landfill donated \$300 to be
4 put towards our BBQ. She will be looking for other restaurants to donate
5 potato salad, beans and coleslaw, rolls, drinks and paper products. The
6 event will be advertised in the local paper, on flyers and on the back of the
7 utility bills.
- 8 b. Business After Hours-May 8th-Tracy Orr stated she will talk to Mayor
9 Cottam about food, etc. for the event. Because the Village cannot serve
10 alcohol, we will need to combine this event with other businesses. Angel
11 Fire Proud will have a table at this event with flyers for Clean Up Day.
12 We will also discuss the Pot of the Month contest there as well. The
13 Committee wants to mention the Adopt A Highway program for those in
14 town who have a section and have not been taking care of it. Chuck Howe
15 said the rules on Adopt a Highway are very lenient and have no penalties.

17 Will be discussed once we decide what we are going to be doing for decorations,
18 etc.
- 19 D. Public Events to Educate
20 The Committee will use events such as AAFPO, Garden Week, Business After
21 Hours to spread the word about what the Committee is working on.

23 Tracy Orr reported she still has a few people who have not picked up their
24 stickers. Lisa Mitchell reported that everyone seemed excited to get them and
25 have displayed them at their businesses.

28 to see who might be a good fit for this Committee.
