Pledge of Allegiance 12 Mayor Cottam called for the Pledge of Allegiance III. **Roll Call** 13 14 Present at the meeting were Chuck Howe, Mayor Barbara Cottam, Rick Sprott, Carol 15 Rupp, Cindy Sprott, Diane Peterson, Lisa Mitchell, Lloyd "Pete" Peterson, Gail Goodson, 16 Kimberly Morris, Cynthia Collier and Tracy Orr. Marsha Woods was absent. 17 IV. **New Business** 18 A. Elect Committee Chairperson 19 Kimberly Morris agreed to serve as the Chairperson for the Beautification 20 Committee. **B.** Elect Committee Vice Chairperson 21 22 Lisa Mitchell agree to serve as the Vice Chairperson for the Beautification Meeting. 23 C. Discuss Mission Statement 24 New Mexico Clean & Beautiful's mission statement is "to engage individuals to take 25 greater responsibility for their community environment". The Committee agreed to 26 change the slogan to read "to engage individuals to take greater responsibility for 27 their community's beautification". This mission statement has been adopted by the 28 Beautification Committee. 29 D. Receive briefing from Village Manager regarding current Village Hall beautification 30 plans 31 Frank Salois, Streets Supervisor, explained what the Village has planned for the area 32 out in front of the building. He stated that the Village plans to work on the area in 33 between the Recycle Park and the Mini Mart. Drainage work will be done and the 34 area planted to look appealing. Several plants/flowers were suggested such as 35 Bleeding Hearts, Tulips, Irises, Shasta Daisies, Wildflowers and Russian Blue Sage. 36 These are all hardy plants/flowers for this area. Watering will be done from non-37 potable water. Rick Sprott mentioned that the trees at the recycling park need to 38 be watered before we lose them. Chuck Howe said he would like to get guest 39 speakers at the meetings to discuss various topics of interest to the Committee. The 40 Resort has spruced several corners at the intersection of North Angel Fire Road and 41 Mountain View Blvd. It was suggested that the Village coordinate with the Resort 42 when working on the beautification. The Peterson's informed the Committee that 43 there will be several servant groups coming to Angel Fire that could help plant, etc. 44 E. Discuss Grants and Potential Budget Available to Committee 45 Tracy Orr said she has already applied for a grant from New Mexico Clean & 46 Beautiful and expects an answer in May or early June. Some of these funds will be 47 used for container planting in front of Village Hall and Fire Station #1, planting at the

Community Center and in the median of North Angel Fire Road and the rest will be

used to beautify the two bench areas, one on the corner of North Angel Fire Road and Valley Road and the other at the corner of North Angel Fire Road and Vail. There may be some funds left over from the Streets Department budget but we won't know about this until probably June.

F. Discuss Short Range Projects

Some of the projects discussed were Christmas decorations, banners on the light posts, business participation in the beautification effort, building code enforcement, planting wildflowers (Anne Supple is the source for wildflowers), adding a student committee member from MVHS and creating sub-committees to tackle these projects. Also discussed were outdoor artwork (murals, paintings, sculptures) and dedicating bushes, trees, flowers to loved ones. Involving local landscapers in the projects was another topic discussed. The Mayor volunteered to contact Dr. Boyd at MVHS about adding a student member to the committee

G. Discuss Long Range Projects

The Village offices were discussed and several agreed they need updating however, there are no funds for this at this time. The Committee discussed the entrance to Angel Fire at the blinking light, ordinances and building codes, and bus stops as possible long term projects.

V. Requests and Responses from the Audience

There were no audience members at the meeting.

VI. Next Meeting Date

The Committee decided on Friday, May 10, 2013 at 2pm at Village Hall for their next meeting date. Chuck Howe asked everyone to make a list of their short range and long range projects and be prepared to discuss them at the next meeting.
