Pedestrian Trails Committee Meeting Minutes

- I. Call to Order
Chairperson Brian Smith called the meeting to order at 3:35pm.
- II. Pledge of Allegiance
Chairperson Brian Smith called for the Pledge of Allegiance.
- III. Roll Call
Present at the meeting were Brian Smith, Lisa Morgan, Robin May, Charles Earhart, Carolyn Smith, Katrina White and Tracy Orr, staff support.
- IV. Approval of April 9, 2014 Agenda
Robin May made a motion to approve the agenda as written. The motion was seconded by Brian Smith and passed unanimously.
- V. Approval of Minutes from the February 5, 2014 Meeting
Robin May made a motion to approve the minutes from the February 5, 2014 meeting as written. The motion was seconded by Carolyn Smith and passed unanimously.
- VI. Old Business
 - A. New Brochure with Snowshoeing and Cross Country Information
Tracy Orr reported that Janet Sailor is working on this project and will have something for us before we run out of our current brochures. The Committee will have a chance to proof the new brochure before it goes to print and before it is placed on our website.
 - B. Bench on Oesta Vista
It was recommended that the Committee help get AAFPO and Trekkers together to pick a bench style, purchase it, have a plaque made and get it delivered to the site. Lisa Morgan offered to talk to the Trekkers and Charles Earhart will contact Lyn Heafy at the Resort to determine what bench they wish to purchase and how it will be paid for.

- VIII. Reports and Updates
 - A. Sendero North-Tracy Orr reported that the environmental report is currently being done for this trail. Once it is done and complete, we will be able to start on the trail construction.
 - B. Sendero South-The Committee determined that this trail should be on the west side of Highway 434 when it is ready for construction. We may have some wetland issues to deal with when we get ready to start this project. This project is about 2 years off from even starting.
 - C. Bobcat-This trail looks fine.
 - D. Sage Lane-Tracy Orr said she will meet with Wayne Phillips, the Village's maintenance man, to see what can be done on the trailhead.
 - E. Lady Slipper-Katrina White reported that there are trees down across the trail on the Forest Service side. The bridge also has some damaged boards.
 - F. Trailhead Parking-Everything seems to be okay except the trail parking sign by Deer trail is missing. Tracy Orr said our Streets Department has it and she will talk to them about

getting the knocked-down trailhead signs back up and placed where they won't get knocked down by the snowplows.

G. AAFPO-Charles Earhart reported that AAFPO has new trail signs going in soon.

IX. Other Business

Brian Smith discussed doing a monthly "schedule of maintenance" calendar for both AAFPO and the Village.

Katrina White and Brian and Carolyn Smith reported a couple of old discarded couches in a gully on Valley Road, past the Community Center but before you get to Back Basin Road.

Tracy Orr will get new Councilor Rogers Lanon's contact information for Brian Smith. He will ask Rogers if he's interested in becoming our Council Liaison.

Brian Smith said he would like to see the Resort develop a trail system for hikers at the ski area. This was discussed for awhile.
