Pedestrian Trails Meeting Minutes  
Wednesday, December 4, 2013 at 3:30pm at Village Hall

- I. Call to Order  
The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Brian Smith.
- II. Pledge of Allegiance  
Brian Smith called for the Pledge of Allegiance.
- III. Roll Call  
Present at the meeting were Brian Smith, Diane Mereness, Charles Earhart, Carolyn Smith, Robin May and Katrina White.
- IV. Approval of the Agenda  
Brian Smith made a motion to approve the agenda as written. The motion was seconded by Carolyn Smith and passed unanimously.
- V. Approval of the October 30, 2013 meeting minutes  
Katrina White made a motion to approve the minutes from the October 30, 2013 with the following changes: Line 52 should read "...the trail can just be mowed periodically." Line 59 should read "...that Angel Fire Resort and AAFPO would like to expand Nordic skiing and snowshoeing beyond the Nordic Center on un-groomed greenbelt trails. The Committee discussed signage needed for Nordic skiing and snowshoeing on the greenbelt trails." Brian Smith seconded the motion with the changes and the October 30, 2013 minutes were passed unanimously.
- VI. Old Business
  - A. Trekker's Donated Bench-Brian Smith brought pictures of the proposed bench for the Committee to review. Charles Earhart said the benches the Resort owns are from a company called Wabash. The Resort would like any new benches to have the same look as the existing ones. Since the Trekkers are purchasing the bench, the final decision should be up to them as long as their bench looks very similar to the ones the Resort already has.
  - B. Snowshoeing on Greenbelts-Brian Smith reported that he could not find a published rating system for snowshoe trails online. He came up with a rating system for the Committee to review. He suggested that we change the trails brochure to reflect the snowshoe trails with the rating system. Tracy Orr said she will talk to Janet and Jimmy about making those changes. We could include an insert in the brochure as well as add snowshoeing to the website.
- VII. New Business
  - A. Update on Sendero South-the Committee discussed the possibility of building a trail on the east side of Highway 434 going south from Country Club Drive. We need to find out who owns that property to see if is feasible. It was suggested that Tracy Orr contact Gary Krueger to find out who owns some of the land along the highway.

  - A. Sendero North-Tracy Orr will work on updating the easement letters for CS Ranch and the Resort for the future trail going to the Sports Complex.
