## **RESOLUTION NO. 2013-23**

## A Resolution to Request Participation in the Local Government Road Fund Program and to Request a Match Waiver from the New Mexico Department of Transportation for the Reconstruction of Camino Grande

WHEREAS, the Village of Angel Fire and the New Mexico Department of Transportation shall enter into a Cooperative Agreement;

WHEREAS, the total cost of the project will be \$281,696 to be funded in proportional share by the parties hereto as follows:

A. New Mexico Department of Transportation's share shall be 75% or \$211,272

and

B. The Village of Angel Fire's proportional matching share shall be 25% or \$70,424
TOTAL PROJECT COST IS \$281,696

The Village of Angel Fire\_shall pay all costs, which exceed the total amount of \$281,696.

WHEREAS, 18 NMAC 27.3 allows Public Entities who are experiencing financial hardship to apply for a Match Waiver of all or part of the proportional matching share.

WHEREAS, the Village of Angel Fire has a limited tax base which limits the funding for meeting the proportional matching share; and, a fund exists in the NMDOT appropriated by the New Mexico State Legislature for Public Entities in need of "hardship" match money and the Village of Angel Fire requests participation in this Match Waiver Program in the amount of \$70,424.

Now therefore, be it resolved that the Village of Angel Fire\_determines, resolves, and orders as follows:

- A. That the project for this Cooperative Agreement is adopted and has a priority standing.
- B. The agreement terminates on June 30, 2015 and the Village of Angel Fire incorporates all the agreements, covenants, and understandings between the parties hereto concerning the subject matter hereof, and all such covenants, agreements, and understandings have been merged into the written agreement.
- C. The Village of Angel Fire shall enter into Cooperative Agreement Project with the New Mexico Department of Transportation for LGRF Project Year 2013-2014 for planning, design, drainage improvements, reconstruction and construction management of Camino Grande from NMSR 434 to Moreno Valley High School and; within the control of the Village of Angel Fire in Angel Fire, New Mexico.
