

**Declaration of Drought Emergency in the Village of Angel Fire  
Proclamation 2013-02**

**WHEREAS**, a long and continuing period of unusually dry weather, abnormally low stream flows, and reduced groundwater levels have resulted in shortages of water supplies with Angel Fire, and;

**WHEREAS**, the ground fuels, surface fuels and crown fuels states within Angel Fire and the Moreno Valley are extremely dry and currently constitute an extreme fire danger, and;

**WHEREAS**, these conditions and water shortages may endanger the health, safety, and welfare of a significant number of Angel Fire citizens, threaten our natural resources, and have created and threaten to create problems greater in scope than municipal and county governments alone may resolve, and;

**WHEREAS**, conservation measures are necessary to reduce the severity of these water shortfalls, and to protect the health, safety, and welfare of affected citizens in Angel Fire, and;

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with criteria established by the Village of Angel Fire Ordinance 2001-06 for natural resource shortages, a review of climatic, hydrologic, and water supply conditions indicate the existence of a drought and water shortage emergency in Angel Fire;

**THEREFORE**, the Governing Body of the Village of Angel Fire, by virtue of the authority vested does hereby declare, order, direct, and certify as follows:

1. A state of drought and available water shortage emergency exists in the Village of Angel Fire.
2. Implement the regulations set forth in the Village of Angel Fire Ordinance 2001-06, Restricting or Prohibiting the use of water from the Village's water system in accordance with Article 3, Level Two, consistent with the provisions of the Village of Angel Fire Emergency Water Conservation Ordinance:


**LEVEL TWO, BLUE FLAG.**

- 1) Two day per week outdoor watering restrictions. Odd street addresses are allowed outdoor watering on Wednesdays and Saturdays; even street addresses are allowed outdoor watering on Thursdays and Sundays. Outdoors watering on designated days shall only be allowed between the hours of 6 and 10 a.m. and 6 and 10 p.m.
- 2) Planting of new sod or turf is not recommended.
- 3) The filling of hot tubs is not recommended.
- 4) Water is not allowed to run unattended or to run off property in a wasteful manner.
- 5) Cleaning of outdoor hard surfaces (streets, driveways, sidewalks, buildings) is prohibited.
- 6) Vehicle washing is discouraged and prohibited for fund raising events.

The above restrictions and prohibitions are applicable to the Village of Angel Fire's water system to include all Village of Angel Fire metered water service. Exceptions are evaluated on a case by case basis, but in all cases, permits authorizing an exception must be obtained in advance.

This Proclamation shall take effect immediately.
